**Boniface and Carol** have been doing well in their studies and I am encouraging them to work even harder.

**Simon** sat for his final primary school (Standard 8) exams. Results will be out shortly after the Christmas break, awaiting secondary school admissions later in January next year. We have high hopes for him.
